Dayton Christian High School (DCHS) students have been a steady presence at the


Gospel Mission this year. In January, several groups of students performed a variety of services at the Mission as part of their "J" Term Urban Ministry class.

In March, "Resounding Joy", the DCHS chorale group, under the direction of Miss Tracy Miller, ministered to the spiritual needs of over 80 guests, presenting a mixture of traditional hymns and contemporary Christian worship music for nearly one hour. *Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands.* Psalm 100:1

Finally, in April, DCHS ministered

to the physical needs of our guests, through a gift of nearly 100 cubic feet of food, beverage, paper and cleaning products that the students collected for distribution to our guests. From the generous gift, 36 "Easter Baskets" were assembled and distributed to families residing near and/or serviced by the Mission. Each basket included a large variety of staples and other items, including a frozen ham and meat from the mission. Even after completing all of the baskets, we still had a large number of items which we used to replenish the shelves at the Frequent Guest Store. Nehemiah Bible Institute Report (Director, Gerry Grimson)



At Nehemiah Bible Institute, we systematically teach the Scriptures to guests of the mission who have a poor or often confused understanding of the Bible.

Students attend quarterly classes that are designed to expose the student to the full range of Biblical material—from the Old Testament to the New Testament—and to prepare the student to study the Bible on their own.

The program sequence begins with a class on the basics of Christian faith and practice. This gives a common grounding for the students from new believer to experienced Bible practitioner. We then teach the students how to study the Bible with a beginning class on inductive Bible study in order to prepare the student for a lifetime of study. From these basic classes we then move into surveys of OT History, Literature, and Prophecy. Next we survey the NT Gospels, Pauline letters, and general Epistles.

With the basics and Bible surveys under their belt, our students begin a study of the elementary doctrines of the Christian faith with an introduction in two classes to the various disciplines of Systematic Theology. Once a student has completed all ten classes of the basics, surveys, and doctrines, there are opportunities to do in-depth studies in a variety of topics. We have previously studied the books of Romans, Hebrews, John, Acts and Exodus. We have studied Reformation history, Early Church history, and End Times.

Students are welcome to join anytime and can complete classes for a certificate in as little as a year and a half. A new sequence of classes is beginning this fall and it is an exciting time to see who the LORD will bring into class.
